


Option 1

- ★ No-cost reading by the author of her new book *What Makes a Dancer* in assembly format for the school body followed by a Q&A with the students.
- ★ On the day of the reading, a letter provided by Artis Press is sent home with each student with the opportunity to purchase *What Makes a Dancer*.
- ★ Length: 1 hour
- ★ Cost to the School: \$0
- ★ Fundraising Opportunity: No

Option 2

- ★ Paid reading by the author followed by Q & A in assembly format.
- ★ Fundraising opportunity where part of the income from book sales goes back to the school.
- ★ Length: 1 hour
- ★ Speaker Fee: \$300
- ★ Fundraising Opportunity: Yes, school receives 15% on the sale of each book.



Option 3

- ★ Half or Full Day Workshop, in which the author works with smaller groups (such as PE, art, or LA classes), teaching students and teachers how to “Dance a Book.”
- ★ Permission for teachers to use the author's “Dance a Book” process with other books and students.
- ★ Curricular Outcomes in art, LA, PE, etc covered through “Dance a Book,” as well as a program that creates community, gets kids moving, and enhances creativity.
- ★ Length: Half or Full Day (available Thursday afternoons or Friday full days)
- ★ Workshop Fee: Half Day- \$500; Full Day- \$800
- ★ Fundraising opportunity: Yes, School receives 20% on the sale of each book



We hope you will consider one of the above options. Beyond the excitement and unique opportunity for your students and staff to connect with a published, local author, as well as the potential financial benefits to your school, there are many important lessons to be learned from this book and program.

- ★ You don't need to be a trained dancer to enjoy the benefits of dancing
